

# **TWO FEDERAL REGULATIONS GOVERNING TITLE IV FINANCIAL AID PROGRAMS**

## **SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS**

Federal regulations require that students be making satisfactory academic progress each year in order to be eligible for Title IV funding (i.e., federal loans, Javits Fellowships, and College Work-Study). The standards by which satisfactory academic progress is measured are determined by the graduate school and by individual departments. ## **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REFUND POLICY**
